

Allowing Visitors to Change the Page Language

WHMCS includes multiple Client Area and store translations through files in the `lang` directory. You can choose whether to allow customers to select their own language from a language menu.

Enable the Language Menu

To enable the language menu in the Client Area:

1. Go to **Configuration > System Settings > General Settings (Setup > General Settings** prior to WHMCS 8.0).
2. Choose the **Localization** tab.
3. Check **Enable Language Menu**.

4. Click **Save Changes**.

Visitors will now see a button in the bottom-right corner of the page that they can use to select their preferred language.
