

Configuring the Enom Lookup Provider

To allow your customers to search for and find the domains they want to buy, you must configure a lookup provider. The lookup provider searches to determine whether the domain is available for purchase.

The steps below configure Enom as the lookup provider using the **Domain Registrar** option.

Configure Enom as Your Lookup Provider

- !** Before you can configure Enom as a lookup provider, you must configure Enom in WHMCS as a domain registrar. For steps to do this, see [Configuring the Enom Registrar](#).

To configure your lookup provider in WHMCS:

1. Go to **Configuration > System Settings > Domain Pricing**.
2. Under **Lookup Provider**, click **Change**.



3. Click **Select** under **Domain Registrar**.
4. Click **Enom**.
