

Setting the Default Nameservers for Domain Registration Orders

You can specify the default nameservers that the system uses when clients place an order for a new domain or transfer in a domain.

The customer is always able to change these to their own nameservers, but supplying a default nameserver can make signing up for your service easier for your customers.

Set your Default Nameservers

To set your default nameservers:

1. Go to the **Domains** tab at **Configuration > System Settings > General Settings**.



2. For the **Default Nameserver** settings, enter up to five nameservers.

Default Nameserver 1	<input type="text" value="ns1.example.com"/>
Default Nameserver 2	<input type="text" value="ns2.example.com"/>
Default Nameserver 3	<input type="text"/>
Default Nameserver 4	<input type="text"/>
Default Nameserver 5	<input type="text"/>

3. Click **Save Changes**.
