Configuring WHMCS to Use SMTP in WHMCS 7


WHMCS comes with the ability to send email without any additional configuration using the PHP *mail()* function. However, the best method to reliably send mail uses SMTP.

To configure SMTP in WHMCS 8+, see <u>Configuring WHMCS to Use SMTP for WHMCS 8+</u>.

Configure SMTP

To configure SMTP:

1. Go to the **Mail** tab at **Setup > General Settings**.



- 2. For **Mail Type**, choose *SMTP*.
- 3. Configure the displayed SMTP settings.

Make certain that you enter **SMTP Port** and **SMTP SSL Type** correctly. Incorrect settings can prevent WHMCS from sending mail.

- 2. Go to Email >> Email Accounts


